Electric Pontoon Legs

This innovative lifting system enables pontoon boats to literally stand on their own four feet using nothing more than the power from a 12 volt battery. Whenever you pull into shore, on any type of bottom, you can raise your boat clear of the water in seconds with the touch of a button. Like conventional Hewitt Lifts, this made-to-go system helps protect your pontoon from the damaging effects of waves and water for longer service life and higher resale value.

Hewitt Electric Pontoon Legs are constructed from high-grade structural aluminum and solidly bolted to the frame members of your pontoon boat. The complete system adds only 385 lbs and has a load capacity of 6000 lbs. Maximum lift height is typically 5-1/2' from the bottom of the legs to top of the boat deck or 3-1/2' to the bottom of the pontoons.

Standard Features

- All-electronic lifting mechanism. A powerful 12 volt DC motor coupled to an acme screw and nut is used to drive each heavy-duty frame leg module. This design provides a positive self-locking lift at any height.
- 4-way and independent position control. Allows quick extension and retraction of all four legs plus individual adjustment of any leg to easily level your boat.
- Low profile design. Legs extend less than 6-1/2" below deck in their stowed position. Will not interfere with trailering or normal operation.
- Large 11-1/2" x 22-1/2" tubular feet evenly distribute weight over a large area for solid footing on hard or soft bottoms. Feet pivot independently for added stability on rocky or uneven terrain.

Electronic Control Module

The command center is fully sealed for protection against water and vibration. It's designed to mount directly above the transom to simplify installation and conserve valuable storage space.



Works with most makes and models

Hewitt Electric Pontoon Legs can be installed on virtually any twin tube pontoon boat and most tri-toon models with at least 12" of space between the pontoons.

Hydraulic Pontoon Legs

Hewitt Hydraulic Pontoon Legs are available in three models to best match the size, style and operating conditions of your pontoon boat. Like the Hewitt electric system, these models help preserve the appearance and value of your pontoon, eliminate the need to tie off your boat and free up space at your dock. Enjoy the convenience of push-button operation and the flexibility of a built-in lift that travels with your pontoon.

Built to last longer and stand taller

Hydraulic cylinders are the muscles of any fluid power system. Hewitt Hydraulic Pontoon Legs use 2" cylinders which are 20% stronger than those of competitors. The rest of the supporting structure, including mounting brackets, legs and feet, are made from structural aluminum which offers a high strength-to-weight ratio and natural corrosion resistance. Hewitt Hydraulic Legs are also well suited to deeper water applications. At maximum leg extension, the top of the boat's deck is approximately 6' above the bottom of the supporting feet.

Designed to work with your boat

There is a Hewitt Hydraulic model for virtually every pontoon boat. Leg assemblies are solidly bolted to the existing frame members of your pontoon boat and will not interfere with trailering or normal operation. In the retracted position, legs extend less than 6-1/2" below the deck. Boats can be transported with scissor or bunk style trailers. The Standard model only adds 375 lbs to your boat and has a load capacity of 4000 lbs. Straight Leg and Wide-Base models have a 6000 lb capacity and weigh 425 lbs.

Standard Features

- Wireless remote control and hard-wired onboard control with LifTrack.
- 32" long self-adjusting feet. Feet pivot independently of the legs to compensate for uneven terrain. The large tubular design evenly distributes the pontoon's weight for excellent stability, even on soft bottoms.
- 12 volt DC powered hydraulic pumps.
- Environmentally friendly, biodegradable hydraulic fluid. Will not harm lakes or wildlife if spilled.

Hewitt Hydraulic Legs are operated with a user-friendly four switch control. Front and rear legs can be raised or lowered independently. "LifTrack," a unique LED arc-of-travel indicator, shows the exact position of the legs during extension and retraction. The pendant is compact and durable.

Standard Hydraulic Legs

The standard model is an economical choice for smaller boats with twin pontoons. The front and rear sets of legs are tied together and operate in tandem. Each set of legs is powered by a separate hydraulic pump and can be raised or lowered independently to level your boat. Leg assemblies are constructed from rugged 4" square tubing.



Hydraulic Straight Legs

This model can be used with either twin or triple pontoon boats and uses heavy-duty 6" diameter aluminum tubing for superior strength and greater load carrying capacity. This model features dual synchronized hydraulic pumps front and rear. Each leg is connected to its own pump, providing faster extension and retraction. Front and rear legs can be operated separately to level your boat.



Hydraulic Wide-Base Legs

Wide-Base and Straight Leg models are identical with one exception. Specially designed angled mounting brackets give these legs the widest base of any onboard lift available today – 72"! That's 24" wider than the nearest competition. This extra width and stability is ideal for twin or triple pontoon boat owners who live or travel in areas of strong winds and rough water.

A free-standing canopy system to protect your Pontoon Legs equipped pontoon

Exposure to sun, wind and driving rain can ruin your pontoon from the inside out. Cracking, fading and peeling not only takes away from the look, comfort and function of your pontoon, it reduces the value. Hewitt custom-designed canopies provide years of beautiful, maintenance-free protection. Canopies are available in 120" or 138" widths and a wide variety of lengths. Choose from three styles: standard, tower or peak roof frame with vinyl or SeaMark fabric covering.

Features

- Free-standing frame made from large, 3" square aluminum tubing. Cross braced design allows the entire canopy and frame to be moved in one piece if needed. Screw-in anchoring posts included.
- Canopy frame top with cross bows positioned every two feet.
- Quick-release center support straps keep cover from billowing in the wind.
- Tension cords keep covering taut and simplify installation and removal.
- Heat-welded seams prevent thread rot and water infiltration.
- Canopy length can be extended at any time for little additional cost.
- Four canopy extensions allow easy adjustment for different boat heights.


Our 16 oz nylon reinforced vinyl canopies are UV resistant to prevent premature fading. Choose from 7 popular colors.

The steep pitch of a Peak Roof Canopy rapidly sheds water. Its higher profile and clean lines accentuate the color of your canopy.




Tower Canopy

New HEWITT-built pontoon legs carry a 2 year conditional warranty on all aluminum and aluminum welds. New Hewitt built free-standing canopies and accessories carry a 15 year conditional warranty on all aluminum and aluminum welds. A 5 year conditional warranty on vinyl and SeaMark canvases, excluding fading.

HEWITT Machine and Manufacturing, Inc. further warrants all other parts used on HEWITT-built lifts and accessories, purchased new by original owner, to be free from defects in the material and workmanship under normal use for a period of 24 months from the date of purchase (excluding components and options which carry their own manufacturer's warranty, wherein that warranty will apply.) Warranty is void when misuse or neglect is the cause. Specifications are subject to change without notice. THIS WARRANTY IS VALID ONLY IN THE UNITED STATES AND CANADA FOR PRODUCTS USED FOR FRESH WATER. CHECK ON REQUIREMENTS FOR USE IN SALT WATER.
